The "white pieces" were reference to the vermiculite in our potting soil.</i> <i>-Students only know of plants, worms and bugs living in soil</i> <i>- Some students think soil and dirt are the same</i></p>	<p>Comes from worms/ worm poop - 6 Helps plants grow - 6 Soil is brown - 4 Soil is dirt - 4 In ground - 3 All over Earth -3 You can plant stuff in it -3 Soil has white pieces - 3 Holds water - 2 Different kinds - 2 Worms live in soil - 2 Bugs live in soil - 1 Farmers grow soil - 1 Roots in it - 1 Soil is made of lots of things - 1 Soil is a dirt for plants - 1</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Concepts about Compost</u></p> <p><u>Teacher notes:</u> <i>-Students seem to think that compost is just worm poop</i> <i>- The different components identified were: newspapers, eggshells, apple cores.</i></p>	<p>Different components - 9 Is worm poop/contains worm poop - 7 Is worm food - 4 Worms live in it - 4 Helps plants grow - 3 Is brown - 3 Is like recycling - 2 Is soil - 1 Contains organic waste - 1 Good for the Earth - 1 You can plant stuff in it - 1 May need water - 1 Plants need compost -1 To make compost, you need bugs - 1</p>
